173 S.B. 1196 Underground Storage Tanks	<u>Sec 1A</u> : Appropriated \$1,300,000 from FY 2002 through FY 2009 and \$800,000 in FY 2010.
346 S.B. 1013 State Aid; Criminal Justice System	<u>Sec 12A, B, &amp; C</u> : Appropriated \$1,721,100 from FY 2002 through FY 200 to the State Aid to the Courts Fund. Appropriated \$648,300 from FY 2002 through FY 2006 to the State Aid to County Attorneys Fund. Appropriated \$615,900 from FY 2002 through FY 2006 to the State Aid for Indigent Defense Fund.
347 S.B. 1116 Expedited Adoption	<u>Sec 17A &amp; B</u> : Made the appropriation to the Department of Economic Services for the Children Services line item in Laws 1999, Chapter 1, 1st Special Session exempt from lapsing.
348 S.B. 1137 Appropriation; Community Colleges	<u>Sec 1B</u> : Appropriated \$3,000,000 in FY 2001 for community college operation.
349 S.B. 1148 NAU; Signal Peak; Appropriation	<u>Section 1</u> : Appropriated \$400,000 in FY 2002 for a university center facility at Central Arizona College's Signal Peak campus.
350 S.B. 1299 Appropriation; County Jail Juvenile Improvement	<u>Section 1</u> : Appropriated \$750,000 in FY 2002 and FY 2003 to the County Juvenile Improvement Fund.
351 H.B. 2449 Appropriation; Juvenile Detention Centers	<u>Section 1A</u> : Appropriated \$2,500,000 in FY 2002 and FY 2003 to the State to Detention Fund.
S.B. 1156 Appropriation; Community Colleges; Campus Match	<u>entire bill vetoed</u> : Appropriated \$1,000,000 from FY 2000 through FY 2011 to the State Board of Community Colleges.
S.B. 1182 Appropriation; Navajo Construction	<u>entire bill vetoed</u> : Appropriated \$300,000 from FY 2000 through FY 2001 for the planning, construction or lease of offices for the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program on the Navajo reservation.
S.B. 1308 Mule Gulch Floodway Channel	<u>entire bill vetoed</u> : Appropriated \$300,000 in Fiscal Year 2000 for the state match of costs related to the design and engineering of the Mule Gulch floodway.
H.B. 2072 Racing Revenues; Disposition	<u>entire bill vetoed</u> : Would have shifted unclaimed property revenue from the General Fund to five racing-related funds, the County Fairs Livestock and Agriculture Promotion Fund and the Arizona Exposition and State Fair Fund.
H.B. 2600 Flight Property Tax; Deposit	<u>entire bill vetoed</u> : Would have shifted approximately a million dollars each year from the State Aviation Fund from the General Fund by increasing the Aviation Fund's share of the flight property tax distribution from 50 percent to 56.1 percent.

1 S.B. 1001 General Appropriation	<u>Sec. 45</u> : A footnote stating that in FY 2001, the Department of Health Services shall revert the amount expected to be expended on services to undocumented children in the Non-Title XIX program on review of the Joint Legislative Budget Committee. <u>Sec. 57</u> : Legislative Council's FY 2000 and FY 2001 appropriation. <u>Sec. 92</u> : The FY 2000 and FY 2001 operating lump sum appropriation for the Secretary of State. <u>Sec. 98</u> : A footnote in the Motor Vehicle Division of the Department of Transportation stating that of the total appropriation for the MVD, \$8,538,400 is appropriated in both FY 2000 and FY 2001 from the State Highway Fund for Special Projects.
