<u>Forty-Fourth Legislature - Second Regular Session</u>	
381 H.B. 2409 Appropriation; Floodway Control	<u>Sec. 1B:</u> Authorized \$1,140,000 in FY 2001 Emergency Fund expenditures, contingent on the fund incurring liabilities in excess of its annual \$4,000,000 appropriation.
382 S.B. 1280 Dependency; Employment; Substance Abuse Treatment	<u>Sec. 5C:</u> Appropriated \$10,000,000 in FY 2002 and FY 2003 from Federal TANF to be jointly administered by the Department of Economic Security and the Department of Health Services for substance abuse services.
404 H.B. 2104 Vehicle Emissions Program	<u>Sec. 10C:</u> Allowed the Department of Environmental Quality to fund a study on new technologies for improving the Emissions Inspection Program in FY 2002 through FY 2005. Funding would have been provided from money previously expended on the Remote Sensing contract which was eliminated by this bill.
405 S.B. 1504 2000 Clean Air Act	<u>Sec. 46:</u> Appropriated \$300,000 from the Arizona Clean Air Fund to the Voluntary Repair and Retrofit Fund in FY 2002 to provide repair grants for vehicles that fail emissions inspections.
S.B. 1014 Appropriation; DES; Adult Services	<u>entire bill vetoed:</u> Appropriated \$500,000 General Fund in each FY 2002 and FY 2003 for non-medical home and community-based care services for adults over the age of 60 years.
S.B. 1298 Kidney Dialysis Center; Appropriation	<u>entire bill vetoed:</u> Appropriated \$350,000 in FY 2002 from the General Fund for the creation of a kidney dialysis treatment center in a medically underserved rural area.
H.B. 2053 Appropriation; Resin Bush Eradication	<u>entire bill vetoed:</u> Appropriated \$185,000 from the General Fund in FY 2001 to the State Land Department for distribution to the Gila Valley Natural Resources Conservation District to aid in the eradication of the sweet resin bush on state trust land in southeastern Arizona.
H.B. 2232 Appropriation; Postsecondary Education Financial Assistance	<u>entire bill vetoed:</u> Appropriated \$100,000 from the General Fund in FY 2001 to the Private Postsecondary Student Financial Assistance Program (PFAP) to raise the base level for the PFAP to \$500,000 for each fiscal year.
H.B. 2284 Appropriation; ASU Campuses; Lease Purchase	<u>entire bill vetoed:</u> Appropriated \$100,000 from the General Fund in FY 2001 providing ASU the authority to issue a Certificates of Participation to add facilities to both ASU-West and ASU-East Campuses.
H.B. 2285 Appropriation; Vocational Technical Funding	<u>entire bill vetoed:</u> Appropriated \$250,000 from the General Fund in FY 2001 to the Department of Education for one-time capital funding for a vocational technical education demonstration in an existing structure. The provisions of this bill were added to Laws 2000, Chapter 344 which was signed by the Governor.
H.B. 2316 Assertive Community Treatment Program; Funding	<u>entire bill vetoed:</u> Appropriated \$33,000,000 in FY 2001 to the Department of Health Services to provide increased behavioral health services to the seriously mentally ill
