313/ S.B. 1313	Department of Health Services	-	\$850,000	Line Item Veto of Tobacco Tax 3.5% allocation, beginning in FY 2003. FY 2002 allocation is maintained.
344/ S.B. 1577	Department of Health Services	500,000	500,000	Line Item Veto of sections 128 and 129, which appropriated \$500,000 from the Arizona State Hospital Fund. Also vetoed as part of Ch. 236, Section 46.
345/ H.B. 2208	Department of Economic Security	\$500,000	\$500,000	Line Item Veto eliminated TANF funding for kinship foster care payments to grandparents.
374/ H.B. 2238	AHCCCS	(\$5,200,000)	(\$5,200,000)	Line Item Veto of Section 2A, which would have eliminated a \$5 million Tobacco Tax allocation for mental health grant programs (plus 4% for administration). The Veto maintains the allocation.
H.B. 2152	Department of Economic Security	\$3,266,800	\$3,364,600	Veto of entire bill which provided funding from the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Block Grant to remove the TANF family cap.
H.B. 2563	Department of Economic Security	\$1,200,000	\$1,200,000	Veto of entire bill which provided funding from the Alcohol Abuse Treatment Fund and the Drug Treatment and Education fund for a community transition program for incarcerated criminal offenders and released offenders.
S.B. 1390	Department of Economic Security	2,485,500	2,012,500	Veto of entire bill, which provided TANF funding to DHS, ADE, and DES for developmental programs.
