

BALLOT PROPOSITION #202
Stop Illegal Hiring Act

Publicity Pamphlet Fiscal Impact Summary

State law requires the Joint Legislative Budget Committee (JLBC) Staff to prepare a summary of the fiscal impact of certain ballot measures. The State may receive revenues in the form of fines from violators of the provisions of Proposition 202. The Attorney General and county attorney offices will have responsibility to enforce these provisions. The fines generated by non-compliant cash-paying employers will be equally distributed to the Department of Education and the Department of Health Services for distribution to school districts and emergency room providers to offset costs of the effects of illegal immigration. The total amount of fines will depend on the level of employer compliance, which is difficult to predict in advance.
