

Proposition 131
Lieutenant Governor; Joint Ticket
Fiscal Analysis

Estimated Impact

Proposition 131 would require that, starting with the 2026 election cycle, each nominee for the Office of Governor name a Lieutenant Governor and run on a ticket with that nominee in the General Election. A companion bill, Laws 2022, Chapter 349, requires that the Governor appoint the Lieutenant Governor to serve as the Governor's Chief of Staff, Director of the Arizona Department of Administration, or to fill any position for which the Governor is otherwise authorized to make an appointment.

Because under Chapter 349 the Lieutenant Governor would be filling an existing position rather than adding a position, Proposition 131 is estimated to have a minimal impact.
