

Proposition 310
Fire Districts; Funding; TPT Increment
Fiscal Analysis

Estimated Impact

Proposition 310 would impose an additional sales tax rate of 0.1% from January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2042. The revenue from the 0.1% tax increase would be deposited in the Fire District Safety Fund established by the measure. The 0.1% tax is estimated to generate \$75.6 million in FY 2023 for half the year and \$189.9 million in FY 2024 for a full year. The tax is projected to grow by 4% annually through FY 2043.

The 0.1% tax would not be subject to the statutory distribution formula, under which a portion of state sales tax is distributed to counties and cities. The additional tax under the proposition would have no direct impact on the General Fund.

The monies in the Fire District Safety Fund would be administered by the State Treasurer and distributed to each fire district based on its share of total property valuations for all fire districts combined.

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
