Budget Preparation

September—December

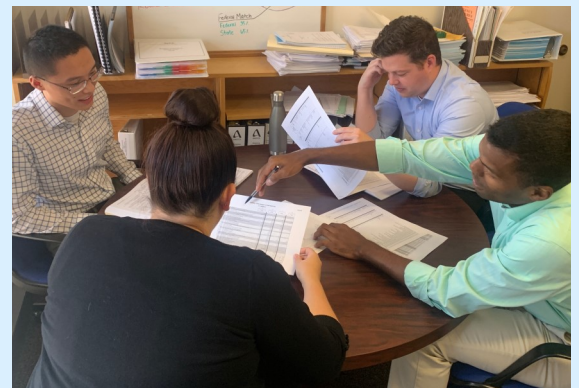
- Analyze individual agency budget requests
- Develop starting point "Baseline" budget estimates
- Meet with stakeholders on upcoming budget



Budget Development

January—May

- Analyze Executive Budget Request
- Testify during committee hearings
- Participate in budget negotiation meetings with legislators and other staff
- Draft budget legislation
- Write Fiscal Notes on pending legislation
- Provide fiscal analysis to all legislators



After Session

June—August

- Conduct in-depth, independent analysis of potential budget items
- Visit agencies to learn more about their operations
- Train new analysts regarding the budget and legislative processes





Living in Phoenix

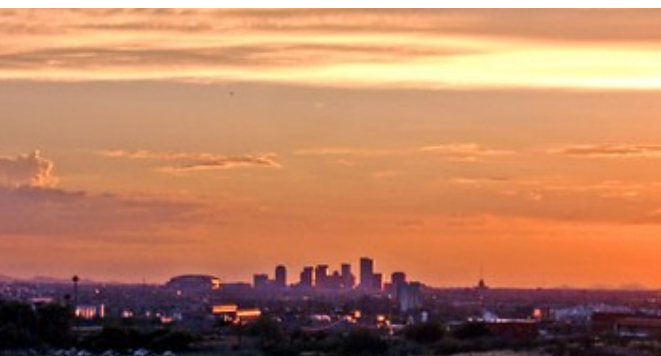
Weather

- Phoenix averages 299 sunny days a year
- Average daily high is 65° in January and 107° in July
- Phoenix is clearly hot during the summer, but it's a dry heat with low humidity
- At 6,900 feet, Flagstaff provides winter skiing and 80° summer highs within 2 hours



Activities

- Year-round outdoor recreational activities
- Close to Tempe Town Lake for year round events and activities
- Urban Mountain Hiking just 20 minutes from Downtown Phoenix
- 41,000 acres of desert parks/mountain preserves with 200 plus miles of trails
- Bi-weekly downtown arts and music festivals
- Hosts all 4 major league sports
- Cactus League Spring Training Baseball
