# **Special License Plates**

## Department of Transportation Program Summary

#### **Program Overview**

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) provides special license plates to owners of registered vehicles in the state. Each special license plate is created through statute for a designated cause or entity. The statute also details whether funding is deposited into the Statewide Special Plates Fund or if a separate special plate fund is created. Owners of the special license plates are required to pay a \$25 annual fee.

#### **Background**

In order to establish a special plate, a statutorily designated entity typically must pay a \$32,000 implementation fee as outlined in statute. The special license plates require an annual fee of \$25, which is split between the state and a specified charity. In general, of the \$25 annual fee for the special plate, \$8 is deposited in the State Highway Fund and \$17 is donated to the specified charity.

### **Program Funding**

Table 1 below displays the total number of special license plates issued in FY 2024 and categorizes them by those that are included in the ADOT Statewide Special Plates Fund and those that are not. In FY 2024, the special plate program generated \$7,419,600 for charities, \$5,595,300 for state agencies including universities, \$11,400 for HURF and \$6,642,400 for the State Highway Fund, for total revenues of \$19,668,700. As shown in Table 1, there are currently 86 special plate types with 960,865 vehicles supporting special plate charities, excluding 4 special plates which are listed in Footnote 1 in Table 1. These 4 plates are excluded from the table because no additional fee is collected (above the standard license plate fee) and/or ADOT is not issuing a new plate style but rather is adding a tag onto a standard license plate. For instance, the "Hearing Impaired" license plate is a standard license plate that begins with the letter "H".

In addition, the following special plates were established in 2024:

- Alice Cooper's Solid Rock
- Arizona Realtors Homes for All
- Cancer Support for Families
- Diné College Warriors
- US Army

The following plates saw redesign:

- Arizona Coyotes
- Honoring Fallen Police Officers (formerly known as Families of Fallen Police Officers)

ADOT also reports that the following pending plates from the 2022 and 2023 legislative sessions launched in August 2024:

- Hualapai Tribe
- Phoenix Rising FC
- Rotary International
